# Quilt, Craft & Sewing Festival

Phoenix, AZ - January 27-29, 2022

**We will be abiding by all Covid-19 Safety Guidelines still in effect at the time of the show.**

Please find below some of the many measures we have taken to increase safety and provide a more open shopping experience....

**\* We have added multiple additional cross aisles, and have expanded aisle width to help ease congestion and provide a more open shopping experience. (This is something we were able and chose to do but stores like Costco, Walmart, Home Depot and Target have not done, or cannot do.)**

**\* Pre sell tickets option available to remove congestion and eliminate cash transfer at the show. Pre-sold ticket receipt can be scanned from cell phone.**

**\* Hand sanitizers at entrances, tables, food areas and restrooms.**

**\* Masks suggested and encouraged.**

**\* We continue to advise any who are not feeling well, with a temperature or other covid symptoms, to please stay home and to not attend the show this year.**

**\* We have increased the number of entrances and exits throughout our show floor to assist in alleviating congested areas in the show. We have also hired additional staff to assist, making the use of additional show entrances and exits a possibility.**

**\* We will be keeping the HVAC on low vent for fresh air when temps allow. We will also be opening the roll up doors (when the temperature and or / wind situation allows) to increase the flow of clean, fresh outside air.**

**\* We also continue offer the suggestion to our patrons who would like a more open, quieter shopping experience --- to attend the show after 1:00 pm (on any of the three days) when the show floor is always more open and quieter.**

We hope this is helpful information to you. We were not able to hold our show last year due to the pandemic and were in fact shut down for nearly 18 months. We know we can be safer than many of the very popular box stores that have stayed open throughout the pandemic (like those mentioned above) and we have taken many, many steps to do exactly that --- to open things up, to spread things out, and to provide for a safer shopping experience.

However, most importantly, we have and will continue to tell our patrons (whom we love dearly) if they lack any level of comfort in attending our show this year --- we encourage them to please sit this year out and we will look forward to seeing them next year!
